WHAT IS THE CHP:

The CHP (Challenging Horizons Program) is an innovative, award-winning program that started at the University of South Carolina in 2009, and is now in Greenville. The CHP won the MetLife After-School Innovator Award from the National After-School Alliance and the Literacy Champions Award from the South Carolina Education Oversight Committee.

The camp will be available for 10 weeks, June 11th to August 17th. Camp will be open from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday to Friday at The Kroc Center Boys and Girls Club. We will be closed the week of July 4th.







DID YOU KNOW

On average a student performs lower on standardized tests after summer break than they did before the break and become approximately 1 month behind if they are not in an academically enriching program like the CHP-G.

Sitting at home, watching TV, playing video games, and snacking can lead to childhood obesity. In one study, the body mass indexes (a risk for obesity) of more than 5,000 elementary school students increased by almost twice as much during summer break as compared with the school year.

ELLIGIBLE STUDENTS: The camp is open to children who will be in K-5 through 8th grade in the 2012-2013 academic year.

The weekly cost for us to run the camp is \$235.00 per child. We offer reductions for multiple sibling groups.
